The Idaho Community Foundation and Idaho Nonprofit Center Announce Strategic Merger

Boise, ID – The Idaho Community Foundation (ICF) and Idaho Nonprofit Center (INC) are pleased to announce their strategic merger, designed to strengthen Idaho's communities by enhancing support for nonprofits through philanthropy, education, advocacy, and collaboration.

"After thoughtful discussions, we are excited to take this next step," said Steve Burns, CEO of ICF.

The merger is driven by a shared vision to increase charitable giving and elevate the effectiveness of Idaho's nonprofits. The unified organization will offer more resources and expand its presence statewide to better serve local organizations and community members.

"This merger represents more than just the joining of two organizations—it marks the start of a new chapter in growing philanthropy and nonprofit excellence across Idaho," Burns added.

Since its founding in 2001, INC has become a vital resource for Idaho's nonprofits, while ICF, established in 1988, has awarded more than \$185 million in grants across the state.
