This cycle provides vital funding to support arts organizations and artists in Southeastern Idaho, continuing the Foundation's legacy of fostering creativity and cultural enrichment in the region.

Grant Cycle Details:

- **Application Deadline:** November 1
- Award Notification: December 2024
- Typical Grant Range: \$3,000 \$10,000 (larger requests will be considered)

Eligibility:

- Organizations with 501(c)(3) public charity nonprofit status
- Public educational institutions
- Government entities, including local governments and libraries
- Must be located in Bannock, Bingham, Bear Lake, Caribou, Franklin, Oneida, or Power counties

Grant Categories:

- 1. **Arts Programs for Public Engagement:** Supports performances, exhibits, and educational programs that provide arts-related entertainment or education to the general public.
- 2. **Local Artist Support:** Includes scholarships, skills training, and performance opportunities for local artists.

Key Points for Applicants:

- Focus on seed funding to help projects become self-sustaining
- Organizations encouraged to outline plans for long-term support
- Grant reports due one year from the application deadline
